BOW CLIP-ON

TOOLS & SUPPLIES

Bow Maker (Large) ART. NO. 8452

Bow Maker (Medium) ART. NO. 8451

Jewel or sparkly centerpiece for the bow

Various lengths of ribbon – ½”-1-1/4” widths

Beauty supply hair clips (to clip to the tree)

Glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS

Choose a larger ribbon for the large bow maker, such as 1-1/4” or 7/8”. Using the large Bow Maker, make either a 5 point or 7 point bow and wrap it around the template 2-3 times. This will make the bow thick and full.

With a narrower ribbon such as ½” or 7/8”, make a smaller bow using the medium Bow Maker. Sew the smaller bow onto the larger bow. Hot glue a jewel to the center of the bow that you have created.

The final step is to hot glue the hair clip to the bottom of your bow so that you can clip your bows onto your tree. (Hint... hot glue the clip holding it open so that the clip doesn't glue together in a closed position).
