GIFT CARD STOCKING

TOOLS & SUPPLIES

Various lengths of Marble Lamé Stripe Quick Bias Tape ART. NO. 760
1/8 yard of Christmas fabric
1/8 yard of liner, such as flannel (optional)
1/8 yard of white fur
1/4 yard ribbon
Buttons

INSTRUCTIONS

Cut out the front and back of a small stocking shape with your Christmas fabric and the liner, large enough to hold a gift card. Cut various lengths of the Marble Lamé Quick Bias Tape and iron it on in whatever pattern you choose for the stocking. Stitch in place.

Sew the stocking right sides together, leaving the top of the stocking open. Do the same with the liner, and place inside the stocking. Cut the white fur lightly larger than the width of the stocking doubled (enough to go around the entire front and back of the stocking). Stitch the ends together and hem one side of the fur.

Sew the unfinished edge of the right side of the fur to the inside of the stocking top. You now should be able to fold over the fur to create the top of the stocking. You can decorate your stocking by adding a button to the front of the fur.

Final step... sew on a small loop of ribbon to the top of the stocking to hang it on the tree. Don't forget the treat or gift card in your stocking!
